Established 1857; last burial in 1910. In 1940's it was
proposed that this area be turned into a children's park
after moving bodies--(did not happen!)**

William died 1897 (2 wives) Shot in ear by Indians. 1867, Spring named after him.
William died 1902 (son of William and Grace Blain)
Don Carlos died 1876 (son of William and Sarah O.)

BLAIN, Jane Slack died 1871 (daughter of John Slack) (WIFE of Robert Blain)

BLAIN Julia Isabelle Died 1880 (dau of John Blain & Serilda Jane Allred)
Sarah Sophronia died 1882 (same)

BOHLEEN, Johanne M Olesen Johnson (first md to Andrew Johnson) died 1881.
Hannah C died 1878 (dau of John F Bohleen and Johanne M O. Johnson Bohleen)

BROUGH, Alice Salkeld died in 1864 (New headstone SE corner of cemetery by fence)
Handcart pioneer

BUNNEL, (in and around small fenced area) NE corner:

Ellen K died 1907 (WIFE of Samuel G, dau of Lewis and Mary K Higbee

COMMANDER, James Edward Died 1860 (buried near Alice S Brough) Infant

HENDERSON, Elizabeth Harris Died 1884 (mother of Charlotte H Allred and Mary H.
Allred)

Member of Nauvoo Relief Society, organized 1842

HITCHCOCK, Louisa Jane Died 1863 (Dau of John C and Petrea Jensen Hitchcock)
Mary Ann Died 1863 Same
May have been 6 or 7 other children also buried here.

HUDSON, Mary Elizabeth White Died 28 Oct 1863. WIFE of William Hudson.
George Died August 1862 (Infant)

JOHNSON, Andrew Died 1867 Killed by Indians. (Husband of Johanne M Olesen)

JUSTESEN, Lars Alaxander Died 1868. Killed by Indians (ancestor of Justesens in Spring City) Note: he had 6 wives.

Caroline Rasmussen Died in 1866. (Wife of Lars A.)

George M Died in 1873 (Son of Alex and Eliza E Allred Justesen)

LUND, Adolphus E Died 1873 (infant) (son of Marinus and Mary Jane Lund)

Druzila E Allred Died 1868. (Wife of Lewis P Lund, & dau of Reuben Warren and Lucy Ann Allred)

MEEK, James died 1867 Killed by Indians. (Wife was Mary Wright, who was here in 1860, probably buried beside James)

SLACK, John Born in England. died in 1881. (Father of Jane Slack Blain) Wife buried in Monroe Utah.

WALL, Alexander B. 1864 D 1865 (child of Frederick Wall and Elizabeth Robinson).

(Note: In the old days sheep were used as lawnmowers to keep grasses at lower levels; however, they rearranged the wooden markers so no one knew where a specific person was buried. It is a safe guess that anyone who died in Spring City before 1869 is buried in this cemetery whether or not there is a marker. Those who died after 1869 could be in either cemetery, especially if their family was in one or the other.)

(Note: first burial in the large cemetery west of town was in 1869, Luke Nield).
