

Sanpete Sanitary Landfill Co-op

Fee Based Service for citizens, businesses, and institutions of Sanpete County

Whitehills and Chester Landfills are owned and (administered) by the Sanpete Sanitary Landfill Cooperative for the citizens, businesses, and Institutions of Sanpete County. The landfills operate under permits from the Department of Environmental Quality and must comply with all State Landfill Regulations. The "Co-op" operates solely on fees paid for waste that is delivered to the landfill. The cooperative does not receive any tax dollars from any city, county or the state of Utah.

Cooperative operates two landfills in Sanpete as follows.

White Hills Landfill: Class 1 Landfill, General purpose landfill: Accepts most items including Household Waste per rules and fees established and posted.

Located 2 miles south on Landfill Road. Landfill road connects with Hwy 137 at 2.6 Miles west of Mayfield or 4.5 Miles east of Gunnison

Chester Landfill : Class IV Construction and Demolition Landfill. **No household waste can be received.**

Acceptable items will be received per rules and fees established and posted.

(Located on Hwy 89, 7 miles south of Mt Pleasant, or 5.5 miles north of Ephraim. Entrance is at the Cell Phone Tower.

Operation Days and Hours.

White Hills Open: Monday thru Saturday except Holidays 7:00 AM to 4:30 PM.

Chester Summer(May 1 – Oct 31) Wednesday, Friday and Saturday 7:00 AM to 4:30 PM

Winter(Nov 1 thru April 30) Wednesday and Saturday 7:00 AM to 4:30 PM

All Loads must be weighed and unloaded by 4:30 PM

Both Landfills observe the following holidays: New Year's , Memorial, Independence, Pioneer, Labor, Thanksgiving and Christmas

Rules:

All vehicles must weight in and weight out and pay fee. Driver responsible to position vehicle on scales

All drivers must show proof of Sanpete residency and address for waste to deliver

ALL WASTE MUST BE SEPARATED AND PLACED IN AREAS DESIGNATED BY THE SCALE HOUSE OPERATOR

If you have any questions, please ask the scale house or landfill workers

All Loads must be secured against items falling our or being blown out. If they are not the scale house operator will assess a \$10.00 fee.

APPROVED METHODS OF PAYMENT: Credit Card (Mastercard, Visa) or with a pre approved credit account approved by the Landfill Administration. NO CASH

Prohibited Items:

White Hills: **Liquids and Hazardous Materials**

Chester: **Liquids and Hazardous Materials, Household wastes**, (food containers, Diapers, Clothing, Toys, Cardboard unless part of C & D, Carpet, unless part of C & D, electronics and TV's, Styrofoam, plastics of any kind, Liquids, treated lumber.

Household waste such as: Upholstered Furniture (Sofas, Chairs) and Mattresses must be separated and placed in Roll Off Dumpsters provided at Chester Landfill

For Specialty waste and large demolition items trailers and boats;

Fee Based Service to Citizens, Businesses and Institutions of Sanpete County

The landfill administration in an effort to make the landfill more equitable for all citizens is implementing the following changes to receive and pay for waste delivered to the White Hills and Chester Landfills beginning **February 10st 2025**

Changes to Operation of Landfill:

1. Eliminate Free 2,000 lb allowance per household per month. (This allowance was unfair because it was funded from the landfill fee paid by citizens through their cities.)
2. **The only Free items** will be large sitting and sleeping furniture (Sofas, recliners, mattresses) (See Limited Free Below)
3. All construction, demolition, yard clean up, trees and limbs and any household waste will be weighed and charged at the current rates \$32.00 per ton.
4. Any vehicle with 500 lbs or less weight of waste will be \$8.00 base fee.
5. Any pickup, trailer, or combination, dump trailers, trucks with more than 500 lbs will be charged the per ton rate based on the type of waste (See website, signs for fee schedule)

Personal Identification and Source of Waste will be required:

6. Residential and Commercial Businesses and contractors from Sanpete will be required to show photo identification and provide address of source of waste.
7. Out of County Contractors will be required to establish an account verifying that the source of the waste originated in Sanpete county or pay the Out of County rates.

Limited Free:

In an effort to be equitable for all citizens, the Sanpete Sanitary Landfill will accept the following items without cost at both White Hills and Chester Landfill to citizens of Sanpete County Cities and residences.

1. White Hills Landfill will continue to accept large upholstered sitting and sleeping furniture (Sofas, chairs and mattresses) at no cost to the citizens. (carpet will be charged by weight)
2. Chester Landfill will accept large sitting and sleeping furniture (sofas, mattresses) to be placed in dumpsters at no costs to the citizens in the North end of the county. Transportation to White Hills will be covered by the Landfill Coop. (Carpet will be accepted at Chester and charged by weight) **(Absolutely no Household Waste)**

Special Notes and Rules Re-established:

1. All vehicles must weight in and weight out and pay a fee. Driver is responsible to position all vehicle and trailer tires on scales and off the rubber liners.
2. All Drivers must show prove of Sanpete Residency and address of waste they intend to deposit in Sanpete Landfills
3. **ALL WASTE MUST BE SEPARATED AND PLACED IN DESIGNATED AREAS. AS DIRECTED BY SCALE HOUSE OPERATOR.** This includes: Construction and Demolition, metal, tires, appliances, yard waste, and household (White Hills only).
4. If you bury household waste at Chester under any other type of waste you are in violation of our State DEQ operating permit and you could be fined for illegal dumping.
5. **Residency in Sanpete County does not entitle you to deliver waste to the landfill without paying a fee.**
6. The Scale House operators are implementing the rules established by the Landfill Administration. If you have questions, the scale operator will answer them respectfully. **If you fail to follow directions or mistreat or threaten the landfill workers,** you may be dismissed from the landfill without dumping.
7. The Sanpete Landfill Coop, which administers the White Hills and Chester Landfills, is funded solely from the fees paid to dump waste. The Co-op contracts with P & L Enterprises to operate the landfill, including all landfill personnel.

Sanpete Sanitary Landfill Cooperative

General Public Information

White Hills and Chester Landfills are owned and operated in a cooperative agreement between the 13 cities and towns in Sanpete County and Sanpete County as the 14th member. The “Coop”, as it is established, is not a taxing entity, does not receive tax collected dollars. **The “Coop” operates solely on the fees paid for waste that is delivered, placed and compacted at the landfill.**

Waste is paid for by one of two methods: Payment of a fee, or payment for tonnage.

1. Household waste that is picked up from the 90 gallon black garbage cans is paid for from the landfill fee portion paid by the citizens to their city on a utility bill or from Rocky Mountain Power. Some cities utility billing includes a “landfill fee” and the carrier cost to pick and deliver the garbage to the landfill. Some cities utility billings only include the “landfill fee”, and the carrier bills the citizen for the garbage pick up separately.
 - a. The Carrier also provides the 90 gal cans as part of his service.
 - b. The carrier does not pay for this tonnage he picks from households and delivers to the landfill. The “landfill fees” pool of money paid by citizens should not be used to provide free benefits to a selected few.
2. Waste picked up by a waste carrier from any 3 cubic yard cans or larger placed at apartment complexes, businesses, churches, schools, hospitals, construction sites, or residential community groups in a joint dumpster is billed for the tonnage at the time of delivery to the landfill.
3. Any private citizen, business, public entity, farmer or rancher who chooses to collect and deliver their own waste to the landfill in a private vehicles, trucks, trailers and dump trailers is billed for the tonnage at the time of delivery.

Rules for Delivering waste to the landfill.

1. All vehicles must weight in and weight out. Driver is responsible to position vehicle on scales.
2. All persons must show drivers license and proof that waste originated in Sanpete County
3. Household, Construction and Demolition, Metal, Tires, Batteries and Plant Life **MUST BE SEPARATED** and dumped in designated areas. If you have any questions, please ask the landfill workers.
4. All Large items which contain metal, wood products must de-constructed with metal separated or metal will not be credited at no costs.
5. Vehicles, ATV, lawnmowers, trailers must include title and have tires removed
6. **ALL LOADS MUST BE SECURED! LOADS NOT SECURED WILL BE CHARGED \$10.00!**
7. **APPROVED PAYMENT METHODS:** CREDIT CARD: (Mastercard or Visa) or with a credit account approved by the Landfill Administration.
8. Out of County Contractors must establish an account for a specific in county project to receive the in county rates.
