The Utah State Library Division has partnered with Fairview City Library, Indianola, and Spring City on this pilot program to offer free library materials to all residents. You just need a Fairview City library card to get started.

Get ready! The library lockers are set to launch in November 2025.

These secure, self-service lockers are located in Spring City and Indianola and allow you to pick up your reserved books, DVDs, and other holds whenever it's most convenient for you.
